A welcome morning tea is planned for the parents/grandparents/carers of our new Kindy students starting at DEPS in 2018. We would like to kindly request the help and support of our current 2017 Kindy families for this event.

We are requesting any families who can assist with the donation of food or drink and/or come along for an hour to help welcome our new families! The morning tea will be held in the school hall from approximately 9:45am – 10:45am, so if you can please come along, babies, toddlers and pre-schoolers warmly welcomed.

DEPS P&C 2017 Wrap Up

One of the big achievements this year of the P&C and our school community was the finalisation of the decision on the school pool. The school will now have a \$4.5 million 25m indoor pool available for year-round use with community access outside of school hours. We would like extend a big thanks to everyone in our school community who helped get the word out for people to register their interest in the community forum, this support was a key reason why we saw the positive outcome. This is planned to open by mid-2019.

I would like to acknowledge the generosity of our DEPS families' financial contributions via the P&C annual levy, building fund contributions and fundraising efforts, your support has been greatly appreciated.

Through our fundraising efforts we have managed to raise over \$35,000 with the Moonlight Markets (~\$25,000) being the major contributor with contributions from the Mothers & Father's Day stalls, family photos, school disco and Election Day stalls.

This year the P&C has contributed over \$170,000 into purchasing resources, improving school facilities or running events to benefit our children. From our current and previous year's contributions, the P&C has committed to the school during 2017

- Brabyn St Grounds Upgrade \$105,000. Coupled with the \$30,000 commitment from 2016, this provides a total of \$135,000 for this upgrade planned for early 2018 in which **all students** will benefit. This is hoped to be completed by end Term 1, 2018.
- Literacy Program Resources \$20,000. The school purchased wide range of literacy resources to be used across **all classes** and the library.
- Air Conditioners over \$10,000 for the replacement of air-conditioners in a number of classrooms
- Canteen upgrade over \$8,000 for the painting, replacement of air conditioning, commercial dishwasher installation to meet compliance regulations
- Resources \$6,000 for art resources to produce the fantastic classroom works of art for Education Week

- Lovell St Grounds Beautification \$5,000 for the purchase of landscaping supplies and plants to beautify the Lovell Rd grounds. This work is currently in progress.
- Music Instrument & Music Purchase \$2,500. Allocated for the purchase and repair of instruments for the school bands.
- Commercial BBQ purchase of a commercial grade BBQ
- Student Representation at National Level contributions to the school aerobics team & Toby D for assistance in meeting costs of national level representation
- Year 6 Farewell
- School Events Kindy Welcome Morning Tea, Ride to School Day, Mother's Day Morning Tea, Father's Day Breakfast, School Disco, Walk to School Days, Lunar New Year & Korean Day

One of the main focuses of the P&C is building our community and families involvement we have seen more new faces at P&C meetings and helping at out events, this is a very positive step. We hope to continue to build on this in coming years.


