Principal Report

Building Update

The school is currently reviewing our signage. With the new spaces and changes to the office entrance we have decided to upgrade and provide additional site signs and information. Fencing for the school boundaries is also being reviewed and quotes are being requested.

The roof on the old building that adjoins our new build is being replaced in the school holidays. Plans are also being drafted for significant playground upgrades with vegetable gardens, a sensory garden and a chook yard being discussed as joint programs with students, DEBASCA and the community. The aim is to create a sustainable learning environment that provides students with opportunity to grow, recycle

and understand vegetable production and living environments.
