Principal Report



From the Principal's desk.

Kindergarten 2021 have completed their orientation and several have attended the playdates in Kings Park with their families. Dates for Best Start Assessment and starting Kindergarten will be communicated soon.

A reminder to students in years 1 to 6 that school commences on Friday 29 January. The school executive have been very busy arranging staffing and classes for the 2021 school year.

Teaching and Learning

Based on current enrolments, we will have 6 Kindergarten classes, 5 Year One classes, 5 Year 2 classes, 8 Stage Two classes, and 8 StageThree classes. These classes will be supported by a large team of specialist teachers to enhance English language acquisition and target specific learning needs. The classes will be arranged to cluster children excelling in various curriculum areas to develop, broaden and enrich their creativity, problem solving, collaboration and knowledge.

Community Language Programs in Mandarin and Korean will continue as the school's release from face to face teaching programs. The Community Language teachers have been working closely with classroom teachers to revitalise and realign the programs to maximise student engagement, rigour and transference and reinforcement of concepts across other key curriculum areas.

The students have had some wonderful learning opportunities over the past few weeks. Stage One experiencing Spring in the Botanical Gardens, Kindergarten off to Calmsley Hill farm and experimenting at school with their Fizzics incursion. Stage Three visited Collaroy for a day camp. All these activities have reinforced classroom learning and provided the students the opportunity to learn with hands on experiences.

Congratulations to all the students selected to participate in the Soccer and Basketball Gala Days.

Presentation Assemblies

Presentation assemblies are not far away and it is exciting that the presentations can proceed but with COVID-19 provisions and adaptations in place.

A photo will be taken of all award winners and students from Kindergarten to Year 6 as a memento of the milestone event. These photos will be emailed to individual families. I acknowledge how important these events are and will endeavour to make them as special as possible.

Stage Three students this year have played a significant role in the selection of the recipient of the Beryl James – service to school award and the Goodness and Kindness award. The students were provided an opportunity to nominate suitable recipients and provide justification for the nomination. A great opportunity for students to recognise and acknowledge other students contributing to school life.

Stage 3 Leadership

Stage 3 Leadership Program for 2021 is underway. Within this process the students will be voting for the 20 nominees who will stand for School Leader in 2021. School Leaders are selected from our current Year 5 students.

Students will be presenting their speeches at school and will have them videoed. Each video will be made available to students within their classroom and they will then cast their votes on a ballot slip.

In 2021 we will have 8 School Leaders. Within those 8 School Leaders, the two leaders with the highest number of votes will be given the title of School Captains.

We are also selecting our House Leaders for 2021. These House Leaders are selected from our current Year 4 and Year 5 students. Students have nominated for these positions and they will be selected by student voting.

Grounds Report

November is time to look into the distance and appreciate the large number of purple flowering Jacaranda trees we have in our local area.

It was once thought Jacaranda tree seedlings were given to new mothers leaving hospital, so they could watch the tree grow alongside their children. Jacaranda trees are not native to Australia. In the 1800's, Allan Cunningham, a botanist, who had developed a love of Jacarandas while visiting Brazil, managed to successfully plant a Jacaranda cutting in Sydney.

Jacarandas were very difficult to grow from cuttings and considered the most precious and rare of trees. However, Sydney's climate was favoured by the Jacaranda, with fresh seeds, from early cuttings, finding just the right conditions to propagate. Jacarandas became a common sight in Sydney during the 1900's.

Today we are fortunate to have Jacarandas with their beautiful purple flowers in so many of our streets around Sydney.
